Eduardo zeroed in on his dream career: welding. Seeing his vision through would require going back to school, which at Eduardo's age would be a daunting transition. He consulted a Goodwill career coach and learned about opportunities for tuition assistance. After three months of training, Eduardo secured a job as a fabricator and welder with what he calls "an amazing company," and is eager to continue to learn and train. He is especially grateful that his new career allows him to spend more time with his family.
