

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF SOUTHERN NEVADA. INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: ...

That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under and pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes, Section 81.290, and we do hereby certify:

- (a) The name of the corporation shall be GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF SOUTHERN NEVADA, INC.
 - (b) The period of duration shall be perpetual.
- (c) This corporation is organized and to be operated exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes. It is not organized for profit nor shall any of its net earnings inure in whole or part to the benefit of private stockholders, members, or individuals. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation is attempting to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise, nor participating in any political campaign in behalf of any candidate for public office.

It shall provide rehabilitation services, training, employment and opportunities for personal growth as an interim step in the rehabilitation process for the handicapped, disabled and the disadvantaged who cannot be readily absorbed in the competitive labor market or during such time as employment opportunities for them in the competitive labor market do not exist. By the inspiration of religion, through the skillful use of recognized techniques of rehabilitation, social work, life guidance, evaluation, training and useful employment, this corporation shall seek to assist the handicapped, the disabled, and the disadvantaged to attain the fullest development of which they are capable.

The selling of articles reconditioned, assembled, or made by such persons as a part of their vocational rehabilitation shall be a necessary part of the religious, social and educational service program of this corporation.

- (d) Any individual or organization interested in the purpose and work of the corporation may, upon election by the Board of Directors and the payment of annual membership dues, as established by the Board of Directors, become a member of the corporation. Each member shall have the right to vote at all meetings of the membership of the corporation, and should be entitled to receive the regular publication.
- (e) Directors of the corporation are to be elected by the members, except that the Board of Directors may fill vacancies in the membership of the Board for unexpired terms.
- (f) The corporation shall have the power and authority to accept gifts and contributions, whether made by will or otherwise, in any form of money, assets or property, provided, however, that the objects of such gifts specified by the donor or testator, if any, are within the objects and purposes of the corporation.
- (g) The address of the initial registered office of the corporation shall be: 302 E. Carson, Suite 703, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101. The name of its initial registered agent at such address is GERALD M. GORDON. ESO.
- (h) The corporation shall have a Board of Directors of 21 persons and an initial Board of Directors of 14 persons. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors are:
